

Website Privacy Policy

Tambria Hunt LLC respects your privacy and is committed to handling the personal information collected through this website responsibly. This Website Privacy Policy explains what information may be collected when you visit **therapywithdrhunt.com**, how that information may be used, and the choices available to you.

1. Scope of This Policy

This policy applies to information collected through this website, including information submitted through contact forms, consultation request forms, and other website features.

This policy does not replace the practice's **Notice of Privacy Practices**, which explains how protected health information may be used and disclosed in connection with counseling services. Once you become a client, information maintained as part of your counseling, billing, or health care records may be protected by federal and state health privacy laws and will be handled according to the Notice of Privacy Practices.

2. Information You Provide

You may voluntarily provide personal information when you:

- Submit a contact or consultation request form
- Request information about counseling services
- Communicate with the practice by email or telephone
- Schedule an appointment through a linked scheduling platform

The information collected may include your:

- Name
- Email address
- Telephone number
- General availability
- Preferred method of contact
- General reason for requesting services
- Other information you choose to provide

Please limit the amount of sensitive personal or clinical information included in a general website form, email, or voicemail. These communication methods should not be used to provide detailed medical information or discuss urgent mental health concerns.

Submitting a consultation request does not establish a therapist-client relationship. A therapist-client relationship begins only after the required intake and consent process has been completed and counseling services have been formally established.

3. Information Collected Automatically

When you visit the website, certain technical information may be collected automatically by the website host, security provider, or other service providers. This information may include:

- Internet Protocol address
- Browser and device type
- Operating system
- Date and time of access
- Pages visited
- Referring website
- General geographic information based on your IP address
- Website performance and security information

This information may be used to operate, maintain, secure, and improve the website.

4. Cookies and Website Analytics

This website may use cookies or similar technologies that support basic website functions, remember user preferences, evaluate website performance, or help protect the website from unauthorized activity.

Your browser may allow you to block or delete cookies. Disabling cookies may affect how certain website features function.

Information submitted through contact or consultation forms is not used for targeted advertising. Tambria Hunt LLC does not sell personal information submitted through this website.

5. How Information May Be Used

Information collected through the website may be used to:

- Respond to questions and consultation requests
- Determine whether the services offered may be appropriate for your needs
- Communicate about scheduling or practice services
- Operate, maintain, and improve the website
- Protect the website against fraud, misuse, or security threats
- Meet applicable legal, regulatory, or professional obligations
- Establish, exercise, or defend legal claims when necessary

6. How Information May Be Shared

Personal information may be shared with service providers that assist with functions such as:

These providers may access information only as reasonably necessary to perform services on behalf of the practice and are expected to protect the information they receive.

Information may also be disclosed when required by law, court order, subpoena, licensing requirement, or other lawful process. Information may be disclosed when reasonably necessary to protect the rights, safety, or property of the practice, website users, or another person.

Tambria Hunt LLC does not sell or rent personal information to third parties.

7. Third-Party Websites and Services

This website may contain links to third-party websites or services, including scheduling, telehealth, payment, social media, or informational resources.

Tambria Hunt LLC does not control the privacy practices, security, or content of independently operated third-party websites. You should review the privacy policies of those services before providing personal information.

8. Data Security

Reasonable administrative, technical, and physical safeguards are used to protect information from unauthorized access, use, alteration, or disclosure.

However, no website, email system, electronic transmission, or data-storage method can be guaranteed to be completely secure. You should avoid sending highly sensitive information through standard email, voicemail, or a general website contact form.

9. Information Retention

Information collected through the website will be retained only for as long as reasonably necessary to respond to your request, provide services, maintain appropriate business records, comply with legal or professional obligations, resolve disputes, and protect the practice's legitimate interests.

Information that becomes part of a client's clinical or billing record may be retained according to applicable health care record-retention requirements and the practice's Notice of Privacy Practices.

10. Your Choices

You may choose not to provide personal information through the website. However, this may limit the practice's ability to respond to your request.

You may contact the practice to:

- Withdraw from nonessential communications

Requests involving clinical records or protected health information will be handled according to the Notice of Privacy Practices and applicable law.

11. Children's Privacy

This website is not directed toward children under 13, and Tambria Hunt LLC does not knowingly collect personal information directly from children under 13 through the website without appropriate parental or legal authorization.

A parent or legal guardian who believes that a child has submitted personal information through the website may contact the practice to request review or removal of the information.

12. Crisis and Emergency Situations
